1. Introduction

2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer, smartphone or other device when you visit a website. They help websites function correctly, improve performance, remember your preferences and provide information about how visitors use the site.

Cookies cannot access files on your device or identify you personally unless you choose to provide personal information.

3. Types of Cookies We Use

Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the operation of the website and cannot be switched off.

They may be used to:

- Maintain website security.
- Remember cookie consent preferences.
- Enable page navigation.
- Support website functionality.

These cookies do not require your consent.

Performance and Analytics Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors use the website so we can improve its performance and content.

They may collect information such as:

- Pages visited.

- Time spent on the website.
- Browser type.
- Device type.
- General geographical location.
- Referring website.

This information is aggregated and anonymous wherever possible.

Performance cookies are only used with your consent.

Functionality Cookies

These cookies remember choices you make to improve your browsing experience, such as language preferences or accessibility settings.

These cookies are optional and are only used where available.

Third-Party Cookies

If we embed content or use external services, those providers may place cookies on your device.

Examples may include:

- YouTube videos.
- Google Maps.
- Social media sharing buttons.
- Online forms.
- Email subscription services.

These third parties have their own privacy and cookie policies, which we encourage you to review.

Consent	Stores your cookie preferences
Analytics	Measures website usage and visitor behaviour
Performance	Helps improve website speed and functionality
