3. Information We Collect

We may collect the following information:

- Your name
- Email address
- Telephone number
- Postal address (if you provide it)
- Any information you include in contact forms
- Correspondence between you and the campaign
- Website usage information, including IP address, browser type and pages visited
- Cookie information (where applicable)

We only collect information that you choose to provide or that is automatically collected through normal website operation.

4. How We Use Your Information

We use your information to:

- Respond to enquiries.
- Communicate with supporters.
- Send campaign updates where you have requested them.
- Organise campaign events.
- Improve the website.
- Understand how visitors use the website.
- Comply with legal obligations.

We will never sell your personal information.

5. Legal Basis for Processing

We process personal information because:

- You have given your consent.
 - It is necessary for legitimate campaign activities.
 - We have a legal obligation to process certain information.
 - It is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest where applicable.
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6. Email Communications

If you choose to receive campaign updates, we may send you:

- Newsletters
- Election updates
- Information about events
- Volunteer opportunities
- Campaign announcements

You can unsubscribe at any time by following the unsubscribe link or contacting us directly.

7. Cookies

Our website may use cookies to:

- Improve website performance
- Remember user preferences
- Analyse website traffic
- Measure visitor engagement

Where legally required, you will be asked for consent before non-essential cookies are used.

You can control cookies through your browser settings.

8. Website Analytics

We may use website analytics services to understand how visitors use the website.

These services collect anonymous information including:

- Pages visited
- Time spent on the website
- Device type
- Browser information
- Approximate location

This information helps improve the website and campaign communications.

9. Sharing Your Information

We may share information with trusted service providers who help operate the website or campaign, including:

- Website hosting providers
- Email communication providers
- IT support providers
- Website analytics providers

These organisations only process information on our instructions and are required to keep it secure.

We may also disclose information where required by law.

10. Data Security

We take reasonable technical and organisational measures to protect your personal information against:

- Unauthorised access
- Loss
- Misuse
- Alteration
- Disclosure

While we strive to protect your data, no method of internet transmission is completely secure.

11. Data Retention

We retain personal information only for as long as necessary for campaign purposes or to comply with legal obligations.

When information is no longer required, it will be securely deleted or anonymised.

12. Your Rights

You have the right to:

- Request access to your personal information.
- Request correction of inaccurate information.
- Request deletion of your information where appropriate.
- Restrict processing.
- Object to processing.
- Withdraw consent at any time where consent is the basis for processing.
- Request a copy of your personal data.
